A. CRIME STATISTICS

There were no crimes reported in Victory Park during the last TWO weeks. **WELL DONE!!**
Last Week only **29** calls were made to the control room.

Residents **PLEASE** when you call in to the Incident Command and Control Centre on **086 18 000 18**, make sure that you tell the controller that you are calling from Victory Park, speak clearly, and inform the controller of the problem swiftly, so the Tactical Vehicle can be deployed immediately. The Incident Command and Control Centre services all the CAP INITIATIVES, so the controllers need direct information immediately so as to maintain the high standards of efficiency that we demand. Please state to the controller if this is an **emergency** or just an enquiry. If you have an **emergency PLEASE STAY ON THE PHONE.**

B. FUNDRAISING POSITION

Victory Park CAP has signed up approximately 185 debit orders, yielding just over **R 125 000** per month in contributions, the vehicle costs over **R160 000** per month to run, we require at least another 48 debit orders to achieve sustainability. At this stage we have achieved **52%** participation!! We have all seen the benefits of the scheme. **IN ORDER TO ENSURE CAP HAS A FUTURE IN OUR SUBURB YOU NEED TO SIGN A DEBIT ORDER - we currently have a funding shortfall of over R35000.00 per month. If we cannot cover this we run the risk of CAP not being able to continue.**
